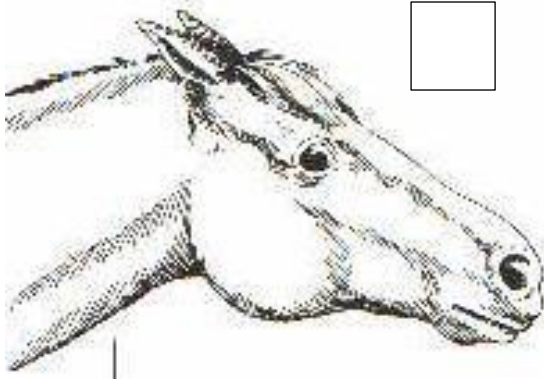

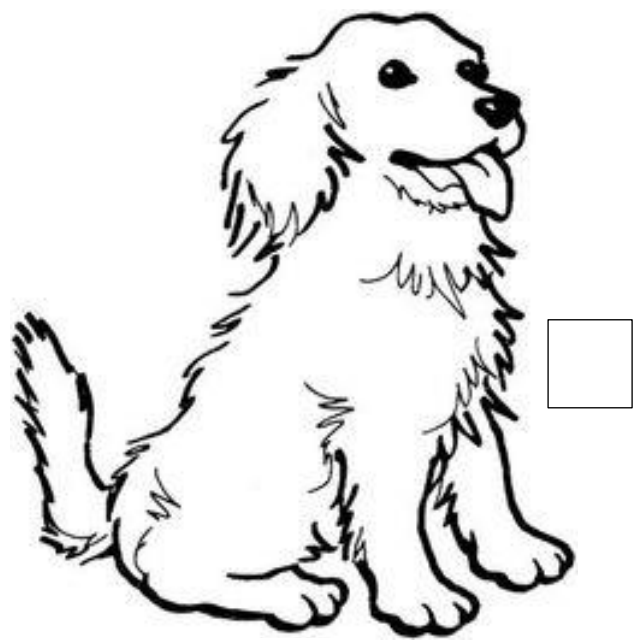
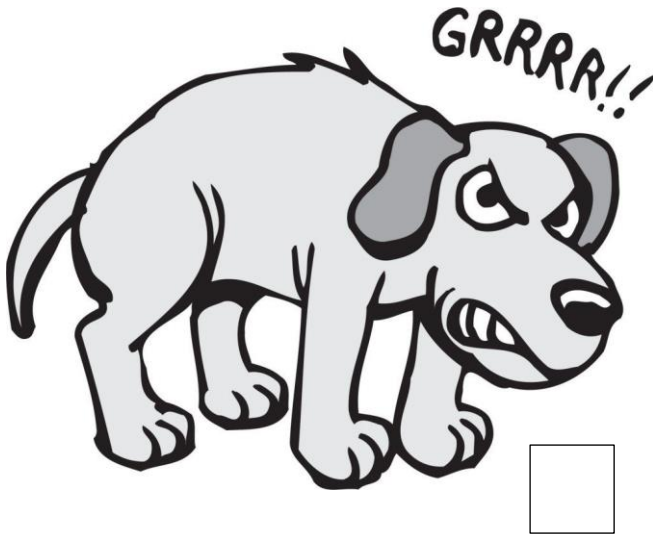
We can tell a lot from a horse by looking at their ears! Circle the right answer!

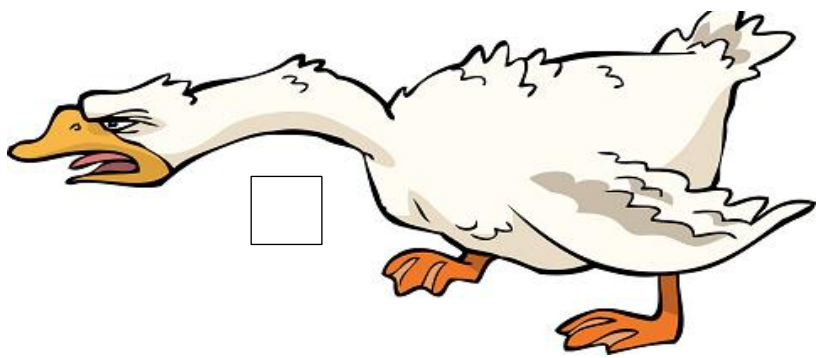
